A TRIBUTE TO "OUR MARGARET"





Her profile in her own modest words:

MARGARET joined Zonta in Emerald in 1993 and transferred to Bundaberg in 2002. Educated in Emerald, Toowoomba and Yeppoon; WAAF from1942-46; joined ANA (airline) as air hostess 1947 until 1950 then appointed assistance executive in passenger services. Highlights were crewing overseas flights on aircraft chartered to Air Ceylon and supervising the flight of Queen Elizabeth from Launceston to Melbourne in 1954.

Joined Wells Organisation – a church fund raiser 1956-58.

Appointed Air Hostess Superintendent of TAA 1958-63 – highlights travelling Australia interviewing prospective air hostesses and visiting the USA 1961 to study training methods.

From 1963-85 was managing editor of family newspaper in Emerald with her brother who was Production Manager.

Was elected an Emerald shire councillor 1970-79 – one three-year term as deputy shire chairman.

Retired when newspaper was sold in 1985 and continued with community services until she lived summers in Mt. Tamborine 1992-99; back to Emerald 1999-2002 before moving to Carlyle Gardens 2002 –to enjoy a better climate.

Was awarded an MBE in 1980 for community service; was one of six finalists in Queenslander of the Year 1983; Citizen of the Year, Emerald 1992.
