
Guest Speakers



Guest Speakers at our April Dinner Meeting were the two Co-ordinators from the Women's Refuge that the Club supports. Their talk was very informative regarding how the refuge operates, how the women who enter their doors are referred to them, the support provided to the women and the funding the Refuge receives. The women participate in a twelve week program which includes workshops on building self-esteem, budgeting, parenting and life skills. In addition, they receive assistance with finding alternative accommodation, dealing with Centrelink regarding benefits and in a number of cases, simply going to a supermarket and shopping.

We heard stories of the successes – those women who, with their children, are determined to move forward, but sadly we also heard of those women who return to the perpetrator of the violence with the violence then often repeated. Club members were thanked for their support of the women and children staying at the Refuge and we heard how our small contributions are appreciated by the women who receive them.

Member Profile -Ros Kinder - Club President-elect



I was born and bred in Wynnum and have now returned to this wonderful bayside suburb in retirement. I have had a number of career changes since finishing Grade 12 at Wynnum State High School. My working life started as a Dental Assistant for fifteen months before commencing a cadetship as a Therapy Radiographer at the Queensland Radium Institute. I left QRI in 1971 to travel overseas first taking up a four month scholarship at the Goethe Institute in Schwabisch Hall before settling in Stuttgart, Germany and working in the 106th Finance Section of the US Army. Back in Brisbane in late 1974, I returned to QRI and continued there in senior positions until I accepted a role as an Industrial Advocate for the then Queensland Professional Officers' Association – a union for public sector employees. However, my career changes were not yet over and in 1991 I accepted a Senior Executive position in the Queensland Public Service as Executive Director HR with responsibility for developing HR policy across the public sector. In 1996 I established my own consulting business specialising in employee relations and drawing on my experience in government and the unions. My practice is still in operation today although I readily acknowledge I am in semi-retirement.

My involvement with Zonta started not long after I joined the public service. I was invited to a meeting and asked to join. I didn't know a lot about the organisation but liked its Mission and also selfishly saw membership as a way to increase my network of colleagues – little did I know just how involved I would become and how much satisfaction membership of Zonta would give to me personally!! The meeting after my induction was the AGM and I walked out of that meeting not only on the Club Board, but as Correspondence Secretary – a great learning experience.

When President of our Club in the late 1990s, another Club asked if I would accept a nomination as Area Director – it had never occurred to me to look further than our own Club. I did accept and was duly elected and this was one of the most rewarding positions – getting to know the II Clubs in our Area which was then Area 5. That was in 1998 and from then on I have had involvement each Biennium at the District level in either a Board position or as a Committee Chairman. My two years as District 24 Governor, although hectic and fast paced, were just magic as I visited Clubs across Queensland, NSW and the ACT and learned just what great things Zonta Clubs do in their local communities – it made me very proud to be a Zontian.

Through my membership I have attended many Area Meetings, District Conferences and International Conventions.
