Goal for all committees in next year:

1. To review / write operating guides / procedures and collate into manuals. Jacinta has volunteered to collate these procedures and present at meetings for members' feedback. Jenny Loy has written / reviewed the Birthing Kit Procedure – the draft will be distributed and discussed at the July meeting.

Advocacy Notes:

- 1. You will have received email from Judith Anderson with attached letters to the Prime Minister, Leader of the Opposition and other parliamentarians, advocating on 3 important issues
 - Congratulating the government for making explicit statements through the immigration process that Female Genital Mutilation is illegal in this country, and pledging support from Zonta District 22 to promote / support any FGM strategies.
 - Supporting the government's laws which criminalise forced marriage, forced labour and organ trafficking, enhancing the legal protection for women and the girl child.
 - Supporting recommendation 6 of the Parliamentary Inquiry into multiculturalism in Australia, which states that legal pluralism is not supported, and recommends promoting the message that multiculturalism entails both a respect for cultural diversity and a commitment to the framework of Australian laws and values which underpin social cohesion.
- 2. International Day of Action for Women's Health: May 28th 2013.
- 3. Domestic and Family Violence Prevention month is held in May to raise community awareness. New three-year statewide campaign was launched this year, aimed at increasing community recognition of non-physical forms of abuse such as controlling behaviour, stalking, threats, isolation. Take action by calling DVConnect Womensline on 1800811811, or Mensline on 1800600636, to seek confidential help on how to respond if you are concerned about someone.
