We were privileged to have Professor Clare Tilbury, Inaugural Leneen Forde Chair of Child and Family Research, Griffith University, as our guest speaker at our September dinner meeting. Clare spoke of her research and practical experience with young people in out of home care due to parental abuse or neglect. These young people have specific challenges with below-average educational participation and achievement, lack of essential family support, and in being poorly prepared for their future after school. Clare shared her thoughts on interventions required for this group and, among others, she encourages projects such as our advancement grants. I have forwarded the first newsletter from our D22 Governor, Ansmarie Van Erp, and included is news from Lyn Agnew, Area 1 Director. There is lots of information from ZI, Convention outputs, and local news etc. There is too much to relate here so please read them and keep up to date as this is important for our Club's activity.

I forwarded also a newsletter from Birthing Kits Australia who celebrated their 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary marked with a campaign to gain support to make 24,800 kits in the lead up month. Their expectations were exceeded with 41 Assembly Days and over 51,000 kits – more than doubling their target goal! Well done.

Our treasurer reported to the Board the funds raised from the Blue Illusion Fashion workshop was 43% greater than last year – a big thanks to the company and all shoppers! Our dedicated group of sausage sizzlers had another successful day in September and many thanks go to all involved. Another sausage sizzle is coming up on 6<sup>th</sup> October as well as other promotional and fundraising acidities this month, so please read on and contribute where you can.
