MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT:

Dear fellow Zontians,

As the time for our February meeting is fast approaching I have started to try and get my head around upcoming events and there are quite a few for which we need to prepare.

It is now only a little over two weeks until our Area 1 and 3 Meeting which will be held on 4 March 2017 at the Maleny Community Centre. I will be attending and a couple of other members have already expressed interest in going. I am hoping our club will be well represented. Last year, 5 of us attended the meeting in Nambour and found it to be interesting and informative, as well as an opportunity to meet members from other clubs. This year Queensland Women's Week will be held from 6 – 12 March. The theme is **Queensland Women: Be Involved. We will celebrate our involvement in this theme at our luncheon on 10 March 2017.

This year the focus is on **Women in the Changing World of Work: Planet 50-50 by 2030.** In 2015, world leaders adopted the Sustainable Development Goals placing gender equality and empowerment of all women and girls by 2030 at the heart of these goals. Achievement of the goals, including ending poverty, promoting inclusive and sustainable economic growth, reducing inequalities within and between countries, and achieving gender equality and empowerment of all women and girls, rests upon unlocking the full potential of women in the world of work. Zonta International and our club fully support these Sustainable Development Goals.

Zonta Rose Day is held each year in conjunction with International Women's Day on 8 March. On this day, Zonta International Foundation asks members to consider a donation to the Zonta Rose Fund. The Rose Fund enables Zonta to continue supporting projects and programs which help women achieve a life free of violence and empower them to overcome gender barriers that hinder their access to health, education and professional resources. This year the donation campaign is running until 3 March 2017. If interested, members should go to zonta.org/donate.

Our club will bring all of these themes, from Queensland Women's Week, International Women's Day and Zonta Rose Day together at our annual International Women's Day Luncheon on Friday 10 March 2017. I am sure that our guest speaker, Pam Parker, who exemplifies leadership and participation in both her community and workplace will be an inspiration to our members and guests.
