Update re Web Site: Beaudesert Zonta

Each member can access this site. Follow the instructions below and update your personal information.

How does a member of the Club register for the District 22 site?

Go to the opening page – http://zonta.district22.org and in the bottom right hand corner, click on the words 'Member Log In'.

This brings up a new page "Login or Register". The top of this page is for already registered members to use with their existing Username and Password.

The registration Form is next for new users to complete. The member completes and then clicks on the "Submit" button at the end.

In response, the member receives an email from WordPress advising that their registration is awaiting approval. A further email is sent from WordPress when the registration has been processed.

Approval is usually within 24 hours and they can then log in using their chosen Username and Password.

<u>TIP</u>: Because the District site and the Zonta International site are not interlinked, separate log in information is required for each.

Zonta celebrates International Women's Day

GUESTS at Beaudesert Zonta's International Women's Day lunch were treated to a special presentation by one of Queensland's most respected and prominent businesswomen

Brisbane's first and only female lord mayor Sallyanne Atkinson AO, kept the 82 strong crowd enthralled with details of her life in the spotlight.

Ms Atkinson, who said she was honoured to be the chosen speaker for the day, spoke about her journey on developing a career in a male dominated industry.

Throughout the years Ms Atkinson has taken on several different roles including as Australian Trade Commissioner to France, Australia's representative to the International Chamber of Commerce, and representative of the Australian Olympic Committee.

During her career she also juggled

marriage and motherhood, responsibilities most women today face, she said. Zonta president Alice Warby said the club was thrilled to have such an accomplished woman address the crowd.

The lunch was mainly made up of women with two men adding to the crowd, Ms Warby said, and was beautifully decorated with purple, the official colour of International Women's Day.

International Women's Day, which is observed on March 8 each year, seeks to celebrate women and raise awareness of the political and social struggles women face worldwide.

This year Zonta plans to continue making breast cushions for women who have undergone breast surgery as well as birthing kits for women in third world countries.

The group will also continue to support girls at Beaudesert State School as well as the high school.


