I would be grateful if you could distribute this message to members and discuss contributions at your next meeting - a wide range of items in terms of size and value is what makes a good Silent Auction. (Please remember that the Conference is on 28-29 September so those who bid on vouchers will be using them after that date. If there are restrictions on when items can be used or an expiry date, it would be helpful to have that stated in a letter from the donor.)
