## Member News

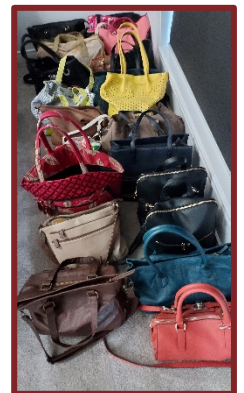

## Service



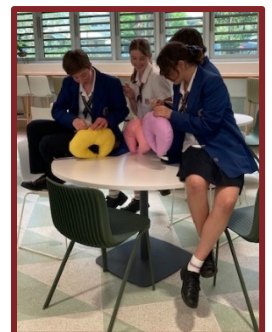

Care Nurse Consultant at the Mater Private who initially suggested this activity and naturally was involved on the day

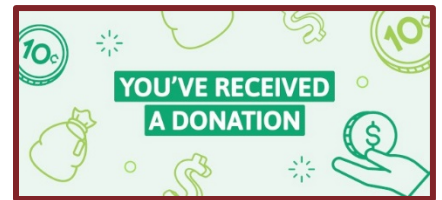
Our next service project is the Christmas Hampers and gifts for the women staying at Madonna House. Please bring your donations to the November Monthly Meeting.

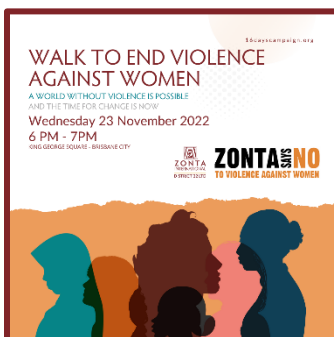


## ***Advocacy***
