Recipes

Milk Chocolate Chip Cookies

Ingredients

125g butter, softened

1/2 cup brown sugar

1/3 cup caster sugar

1 egg

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 1/2 cups self raising flour

3/4 cup Milk Chocolate Baking Chips

Method

- 1. Cream together butter and sugars until light and fluffy. Whisk in egg and vanilla. Stir in flour then fold through Chocolate Chips.
- 2. Place a teaspoon full of dough on greased baking trays. Bake in a moderately slow oven of 160c for 10-15 minutes or until cooked.
- 3. Cool on a wire rack.

Double Chocolate Chip Cookies
