



#### ZONTA INTERNATIONAL ORIGINS AND SYMBOLS

- Zonta International was founded **08 November 1919** in Buffalo, New York, USA.
- The name "Zonta" is derived from the Lakhota (Teton Dakota) word of the Native-American Sioux peoples, meaning "honest and trustworthy."
- Zonta's emblem is a composite of several **Sioux symbols** (see below).
- Zonta's symbol is a **yellow rose**. Since 1999, it has served as the symbol of Zonta Rose Day, which falls on 08 March and coincides with International Women's Day.
- Zonta's colours are **mahogany and gold**.
- Zonta's membership pin is a **symbol of our bond in Zonta**. The Zonta pin is generally worn on the left side. The president wears the gavel pointing up while serving, and pointing down after completion of the term.
