(Melbourne 23 - 30 June 2006)

Place: Central and so good.

Melbourne Convention Centre, right by the Yarra River on Spencer Street, opposite the Crown Casino Complex.

Organisation:99% excellent. All who went to Paris and New York and other conventions say Melbourne did us proud - the best ever!! Well done Melbourne and Area 23.

Briefly....

- 68 member countries present
- 1311 voting delegates

- 2500 involved including guests and speakers
- 5 past international presidents(PIPS) 11 International Board Members
- 29 District Governors and heaps of Club Presidents and lots of members from across Australia and the globe.

The opening ceremony was full of pomp and ceremony but lovely. The flag bearers in national costumes appeared on stage and the Australian Youth Choir sang as the Convention was opened.

Our Past International President Mary Ellen Bittner was marvellous. Well organised, flexible, humorous and warm. The new international president is a very capable, beautiful, talented lady. Some of these girls have got it all. They are truly awesome!

At the convention I witnessed the wonderful international achievements of great value to disadvantaged women and girls that ZONTA is advocating for and the projects we are involved in and where our actual International fees go to work. It really makes you feel that you are in humble little Gladstone making a real contribution and difference.

The most inspiring speakers were Kimberly Boyce Campell (NZ) a winner in 1991 of Young Women in Public Affairs. She spoke about what she had achieved since having won her award. Dr Susan Andrews (the two time winner of the Amelia Erhardt Award). She is a rocket scientist and she spoke locally in the past.

The information on our service projects at all levels gave excellent feed back on their success and this was directly seen in the workshops on Women and Girls in Education, Economic Self Sufficiency Projects

and Women against Violence: Human Trafficking and Women's Health(HIV Aids).

The fellowship: was the best thing as I met and talked with women from all over the country and world and made heaps of new friends.

It all ended in a grand Gala Dinner under 200 golden stars and was worth every cent. The new international executives were installed, the past farewelled and there was wonderful entertainment, scrumptious food and sadness at the end. Farewells of "see you in Rotterdam in 2008" were exchanged.

From Melbourne I went to Tasmania and had Tuesday night with the Launceston Club and gained some more excellent ideas to forward on to the club for discussion.
