

TRIBUTE 4TH JANUARY 2005.



IN OUR LIVES WE HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO BELONG TO MANY FAMILIES. SOME WE ENTER INTO BY CHOICE, SOME BY CIRCUMSTANCES.

CLAIR HAS A VERY DEVOTED IMMEDIATE FAMILY IN HUSBAND BOB AND DAUGHTERS ANNETTE AND MARIE. I WAS PRIVILEGED TO WITNESS THIS DEVOTION IN THE DAYS LEADING UP TO CLAIR'S DEATH. CLAIR'S DEATH HAS LEFT A GREAT VOID IN THEIR LIVES

CLAIR'S PASSING HAS ALSO LEFT A VOID IN THE OTHER FAMILIES SHE WAS PART OF, AND IT IS ABOUT TWO OF THESE OTHER FAMILIES THAT CLAIR WAS PART OF, THAT I WANT TO SHARE WITH YOU TODAY.

THE FIRST IS THE FAMILY OF NURSING STAFF AT THE ROCKHAMPTON BASE HOSPITAL.

REMINISCING WITH CLAIR ONLY A COUPLE OF WEEKS AGO ABOUT THE TIME CLAIR FIRST JOINED THE NURSING STAFF, NEITHER OF US COULD RECALL THE CIRCUMSTANCES, BUT AS IT WAS CLOSE ON 20 YEARS AGO THE "HOW "AND "WHEN" WAS NOT REALLY RELEVANT.

I DID RECALL THE "WHY" HOWEVER. AS THE "WHY" REMAINED RELEVANT THROUGHOUT CLAIR'S TIME ON STAFF.

CLAIR HAD A STRONG BELIEF THAT SHE COULD MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THE LIVES OF PEOPLE WITH DIABETES, AND SHE SOUGHT A POSITION THAT WOULD ALLOW HER TO USE HER NURSING KNOWLEDGE TO EDUCATE PATIENTS WITH DIABETES, AND TO ALSO FURTHER CARING FOR THEM, BY EDUCATING FELLOW NURSES ABOUT DIABETES, ALWAYS KEEPING HER OWN KNOWLEDGE CURRENT.

THE HOSPITAL'S NEED WAS FOR SOMEONE RELIABLE AND KNOWLEDGEABLE IN THE POSITION OF DIABETIC EDUCATOR, SOMEONE WITH NOT ONLY KNOWLEDGE AND EMPATHY FOR THE DIABETIC PATIENT, BUT SOMEONE WHO COULD WORK INDEPENDENTLY. SOMEONE WHO COULD INTERACT DIPLOMATICALLY WITH ALL LEVELS OF NURSING STAFF, INCLUDING THE DIRECTOR OF NURSING, BEARING IN MIND THAT AT THE TIME, THE NURSING PROFESSION WAS STILL VERY HIERARCHAL. CLAIR WAS THIS PERSON.

THE POSITION ALSO CALLED FOR SOMEONE WHO COULD INTERACT WITH ALL LEVELS OF MEDICAL STAFF FROM INTERN TO CONSULTANT, WALKING THE THIN LINE BETWEEN ACCEPTING A MEDICAL DIRECTION, AND AT THE SAME TIME INFLUENCING THOSE DIRECTIONS WITHOUT OFFENDING THE DOCTOR. CLAIR WAS THAT PERSON.

CLAIR WAS PHILOSOPHICAL ABOUT THE MANY TIMES SHE WAS REQUIRED TO MOVE OFFICE AS THE WARD SHE WAS IN NEEDED HER SPACE. BUT WHEN CIRCUMSTANCES ALLOWED A DEDICATED AREA IN THE OPD, CLAIR DEMONSTRATED MANAGEMENT SKILLS IN GETTING THE OFFICE FURNISHED AND UP AND RUNNING, INCLUDING THE ROOM FOR THE PRACTICAL DEMONSTATION AND PRACTICING OF INJECTION GIVING, BLOOD TESTING ETC. ALL THIS WHILE STILL FULFILLING HER ROLE AS DIABETIC EDUCATOR.

CLAIR CONTINUED TO ENHANCE HER KNOWLEDGE ABOUT DIABETES BY ATTENDING MANY CONFERENCES, BOTH NATIONALLY AND INTERNATIONALLY, (MOSTLY AT HER OWN EXPENSE), MAINTAINING LINKS WITH DRUG COMPANIES, AND BEING A MEMBER OF THE DIABETES GROUP.

ANNETTE AND MARIE HAVE FOLLOWED CLAIR INTO THE NURSING PROFESSION WITH MARIE ALSO ACCEPTING THE MANTLE OF DIABETIC EDUCATOR. WHAT BETTER ENDORSEMENT OF CLAIR'S DEDICATION COULD BE FOUND?



THE SECOND FAMILY I NOW SPEAK OF THAT CLAIR SHARED IS THAT OF THE ZONTA CLUB OF ROCKHAMPTON, A SERVICE CLUB WHOSE FOCUS IS THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE STATUS OF WOMEN THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.

CLAIR JOINED THE ZONTA CLUB IN 1988, THE YEAR AFTER SHE COMMENCED AT THE ROCKHAMPTON BASE HOSPITAL. CLAIR BROUGHT TO ZONTA THE SAME LEVEL OF COMMITMENT SHE DEMONSTRATED IN HER PROFESSIONAL CALLING.

ZONTA IS A FUNDRAISING CLUB AND CLAIR WAS ALWAYS THERE TO ASSIST AT ANY FUNDRAISING FUNCTION THE CLUB HELD, USUALLY TO BE FOUND ON THE PLANNING COMMITTEE FOR SUCH A FUNCTION, AND VERY VISIBLE WHEN SOMETHING NEEDED TO BE DONE.

ZONTA FUNCTIONS BY A COMMITTEE STRUCTURE AND CLAIR SERVED AS CHAIRMAN OF THESE COMMITTEES AS WELL AS HOLDING POSITONS OF TREASURER, VICE PRESIDENT AND PRESIDENT.

CLAIR WAS PRESIDENT OF THE CLUB FROM JUNE 1995 TO JUNE 1997. AND ZONTA'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE WELFARE OF WOMEN UNDER CLAIR'S LEADERSHIP WAS QUITE SUBSTANTIAL. I FOLLOWED CLAIR AS PRESIDENT, AND APPRECIATED HER SUPPORT OF MY PRESIDENCY.

CLAIR'S COMMITMENT TO AND BELIEF IN THE AIMS OF ZONTA WAS EVIDENT IN HER ATTENDANCE AT SEVERAL AREA WORKSHOPS, DISTRICT CONFERENCES AND INTERNAIONAL CONVENTIONS. SHE BELIEVED IN THE NEED TO BE INVOLVED TO FULLY UNDERSTAND.

CLAIR ON OCCASIONS WAS ABLE TO COMBINE HER COMMITMENT TO FURTHERING THE CAUSE OF DIABETES WITH HER COMMITMENT TO THE SERVICE COMPONENT OF THE ZONTA CLUB, BY INVOLVING ZONTA MEMBERS IN FUNDRAISING FOR THE DIABETES CAMPS THAT CLAIR COORDINATED SINCE EARLY IN HER ARRIVAL IN ROCKHAMPTON. ONE SUCH FUNCTION THAT COMES TO MIND IS A CHARITY GOLF DAY WHICH CLAIR ALMOST SINGLE HANDEDLY ORGANISED, MY FIRST EXPERIENCE AT GOLF.

WE ALL PRIORITISE WHAT WE DO, WHERE WE WILL COMMIT OUR TIME AND ENERGIES, AND I QUESS CLAIR DID TO, BUT WHETHER IT WAS AT THE HOSPITAL, AND THERE CLAIR ALSO INVOLVED HERSELF WITH OTHER ASPECTS OF HOSPITAL LIFE, OR AT ANY OF THE MANY FUNCTIONS OF ZONTA, CLAIR ALWAYS GAVE THE IMPRESSION THAT, THAT PARTICULAR FUNCTION WAS FOR HER THE FIRST PRIORITY, AND MOST IMPORTANT, AND SHE APPROACHED IT ACCORDINGLY.

THE FAMILY OF ZONTA AND THE FAMILY OF THE NURSING FRATERNITY HAS LOST A VERY VALUED AND RESPECTED MEMBER WHO IS MISSED AND MOURNED.

ON BEHALF OF CLAIR'S NURSING COLLEAGUES AND FELLOW ZONTIANS I EXTEND LOVE AND SYMPATHY TO BOB ANNETTE MARIE AND ALL MEMBERS OF CLAIR'S FAMILIES.
