Following is a summary of awards/donations by the Rockhampton Club during the 2004 – 2005 Zonta year.

1. Zonta Awards:

□ Zonta Encouragement Awards:

Through Central Queensland University (CQU) Zonta awarded **three encouragement awards** for women in the areas of Informatics and Communication, Engineering, and Science. These Awards are **valued at \$250.00 each**. The Awards are presented to the full-time female student with the highest GPA entering the final year of the u/graduate program, in the Informatics and Communication, Engineering and Science Degrees.

□ Amelia Earhart Commemorative Young Pilot's Award:

The Zonta Club of Rockhampton together with the **Zonta Clubs of Emerald and Longreach** offered once again in 2004, an Amelia Earhart Commemorative Young Pilot's Award for Women, **to encourage and assist young women in our Central district to advance their skills in flying.** The recipient will **receive \$1000.00** towards flying instruction. The Award is offered bi-annually.

□ Young Women in Public Affairs Award:

The **Young Women in Public Affairs Award** is offered by the Zonta Club of Rockhampton annually. However this year the timing of the Award was altered to suit the commitments of the students and will be offered in the middle of the year.

2. Local Projects:

□ Breast Care Cushions:

The club continues the service project of **making and supplying Breast Care Cushions** to the **Cancer Fund for distribution** to breast surgery patients. Successful **working bees** were held at Margaret Olive's home in July and November 2004 and again in February 2005. The cushions were completed at dinner meetings where members stuffed and wrapped them for distribution. **Over 350 cushions have been made since the club commenced the project in July 2000.**

Hon Zon Badges were presented to Shirley Shannon and Ivy Santacaterina for their continued support of the Zonta Breast Care Cushion Project. Shirley and Ivy have been sewing Breast Care Cushions since the Rockhampton Club commenced the project in July 2000.

□ Pamper Packs:

Also at the working bees, **Pamper Packs for the women who enter Women's Shelter** were made and filled with personal goodies. Our total delivery of Pamper Packs to the Women's Shelter numbers 130 and they are much appreciated by the women.

□ Support for Local Charities.

In December 2004, Women's Shelter, Salvation Army, Anglicare, OzCare, BlueCare and Lifeline received Christmas Hampers to the value of \$200.00 each. This is an ongoing yearly donation to these organizations.

□ Sale of Macadamia Nuts:

The club continues to sell Macadamia Nuts to raise funds to donate to the Skin Bank.

□ Sale of Coasters:

Coasters depicting the beautiful Zonta Rose of Fellowship are sold to raise funds for all projects.

3. District and International Projects:

Zonta International Foundation:

The club continued to support the Foundation with 2004-2005 donations totalling A\$ 2,000.

□ Plan International:

The Club continued support for an underprivileged child through Plan International - \$420.

Royal Brisbane Hospital Skin Bank:

Zonta Club of Rockhampton along with other Zonta Clubs in Queensland, NSW and ACT provide vital funding for the Royal Brisbane Hospital Research Foundation through the Queensland Skin Bank. Zonta Clubs in these three states have raised over \$150,000 for the Skin Bank with the **Zonta Club of Rockhampton donating \$1,000 in this financial year bringing our total to \$4,500.**

□ Breast Care Cushions:

Club members **continue to make Breast Care Cushions** as part of the District 24 project donating them to The Cancer Fund for distribution.

□ Birthing Kit Project:

The club supported the Birthing Kit Project conducted by the Adelaide Hills Club with a donation of \$200

□ Malawi Project:

The club supported the Malawi Project conducted by the Caboolture Club with a donation of \$100.

□ Tsunami Appeal:
