### 61<sub>st</sub> Zonta International Convention Report Torino 7<sub>th</sub>-13<sub>th</sub> July 2012 (Prepared by Trish Collins, Past District 22 Governor 2010-2012) Thursday 5 July and Friday 6 July

Registration, Credentials and the Foundation booth were open for business with the flavours and tastes of Italy and the biennium of the Zebras (outgoing Governors) evident as the themes of the convention. There was no shortage of good food and wine at any of the ticketed events and those who discovered Italy's cuisine via the many Cafes and restaurants certainly found out that having many courses on the menu is the norm.

#### Saturday 7 July District 22 meeting

District 22 members who were able to gather for the meeting were provided with the following updates on District business.

• YWPA District winner - Sarah Maree Newman has won an International award of US\$3,000. 2012-2014

District Governor, Judith Anderson, advised that she had invited Sarah to speak at our District Conference in 2013.

• On the topic of District Conference, Judith also advised that it would be held on the Sunshine Coast with the venue to be confirmed. (Additional information following Elections on Tuesday 10 July: Newly elected ZI Director, Maria Stefanovic, from Bulgaria will be our international liaison and will attend the District Conference. Maria was a "Zebra" - the group of Governors I was privileged to work alongside during 2010-2012. DG Judith has since advised that the Noosa Convention and Exhibition Centre at the Australis Resort will be the venue.

- Update on Website close to going "live" so stay alert for the email advice.
- · Reported that the final Board Meeting for the 2010-2012 biennium included an induction for the

2012-2014 District 22 Board and hand over.

- DVD of photos from 2011 District Conference were provided to outgoing and incoming Area Directors
- Membership update

ZI figures for end June 2012 = 1099 - district target was 1224

Some District dues had not been received by the District Treasurer even though these clubs had paid ZI - a point to note for club treasurers (please pay ZI AND District Dues at the same time). District figures were only at 932.

-Large number of resignations in some clubs - some have been blue to recruit replacement members though not all have.

-20 clubs (of 47) have fewer than 20 members

-Contributions to ZIF increased though another District had made a large contribution that put them ahead of our District as 4th overall in the world.

-Limited Formal support from Bne clubs to assist with a major Breakfast event to celebrate 1,000,000th birthing kit was received - one member only. Acknowledgment that due to Convention and busyness of club members that timing may not be good in August. Encouraging clubs to use the milestone to hold their own event and get publicity.

- Most pleasing duty at my final District Meeting was to present Jane O'Brien with a 32 year membership certificate and thank her for the tireless work she has done for both ZI and our District (Jane was one of my Centurions). Having just spent 2 biennia as ZI Chairman for the YWPA Award, Jane is stepping away from ZI duties this biennium.

• A District 22 photo of members in attendance was taken by Member Pam Hall and will be shared when she returns from her travels.

• Judith provided a synthesis of the focus for this new biennium - simplification and visibility and we enjoyed a brief visit from both 2010-2012 ZI President, Diane Curtis, and 2012-2014 ZI President, Lyn McKenzie.
