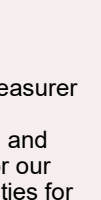
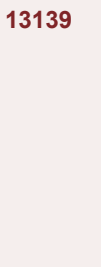

Blue Illusion is supporting Zonta with their fashion parade on May 26. Bring your friends to see the latest fashions.

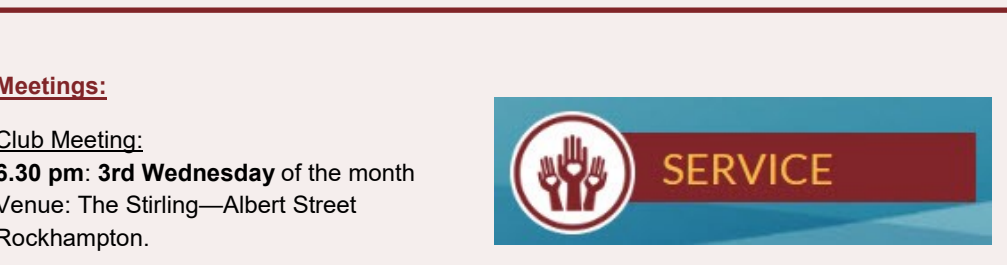
Rosalie will be flying our flag at Convention in Japan. Read through the motions which will be voted on, if you want to discuss them with our Club.

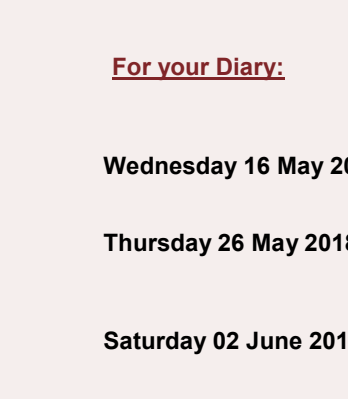

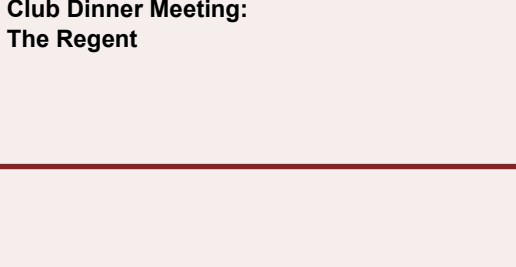

 Nearly 100 years ago, founding member, Marian de Forest dreamed of an organization that would bring together women in executive positions and help them reach their rightful places in the professions that rarely had women leaders.

Since the creation of Zonta International in 1919, our members have dedicated the last century to empowering women, both in and outside of Zonta. To celebrate these achievements, Zontians around the globe will take part in a two-year celebration to honour the past while heralding the future.

Jane M Klausman Award offered to university students.

To encourage more women to pursue education and business in business, Zonta International established the Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarship. Zonta International offers up to 32 scholarships of US\$2,000 each at the district/region level and six international scholarships in the amount of US\$8,000 each.

Women of any age, pursuing an accredited business or business-related program who demonstrate outstanding potential in the field, are eligible and encouraged to apply. For a full list of the eligibility and application requirements, please refer to the application.

Since the program's inception, Zonta has awarded 527 Scholarships, totalling more than US\$1.2 million, to 397 women representing 56 countries.

Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships are made possible through investment income generated by the Klausman bequest, and by generous contributions from Zontians, Zonta clubs and friends of Zonta.

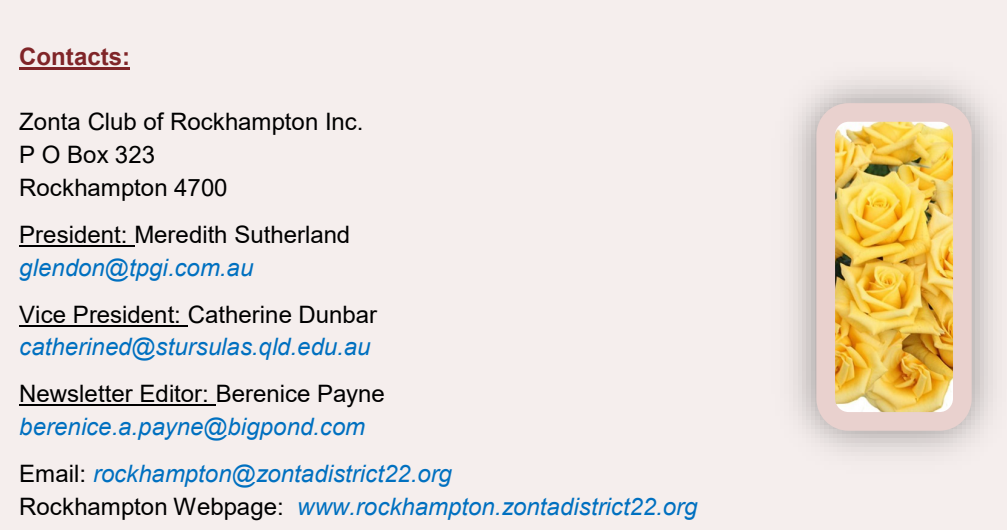
Display at Airport:
