PRESIDENTS REPORT

Hello everyone,

I took the opportunity to introduce our new board and acknowledge the work done of our past President Kerrie and her Board at Zonta's changeover meeting on May 27th.

In Reef Talk this month I want to elaborate more on the board's responsibilities and touch on the projects that we as a club manage-both fundraising and assistance



Some of these are offering local assistance and others are international initiatives. As well, we are committed to Zonta International projects which you will hear more of in the following months.

Please believe I'll never write a Presidents report of this length again but I want to give our new members an understanding of our club inner workings.

The President's duty is to conduct all meetings of the club and the board and act as the Chief Executive Officer of the club.

In collaboration with the board, the president appoints chairmen of standing committees and all other committees (except the Nominating Committee). The president is entitled to sit on all committees except the Nominating Committee.

The Vice President performs the duties of the president in the president's absence and as well the vice president may serve as chairman of a committee or project. (PJ Halter & Laura Morrison)

The Secretary keeps a record of the proceedings of the meetings of the club and the board and conducts correspondence not specifically assigned to other officers or committees (Janice Lake)

The Treasurer is responsible for the funds of the club and administers them in accordance with the approved club budget. The treasurer makes monthly reports to the board and the club and is an ex-officio member of the Finance Committee. (Betty Whitehorn)

- * Our club sponsors Z Clubs Sandii Hansen, for secondary school students The aim of the program is to develop future leaders who will participate in local and international service to advance the status of women worldwide, we currently have one Z Club at St Catherine's however in time we aim to have on in each of the local secondary schools.
- * Books from Birth Lauran Haack, it involves collection of quality used children's storybooks sorted boxed and posted to young children and their mothers who have few resources and would benefit by owning storybooks
- * Breast Cushions, a sewing group Kerrie Adam, providing cushions to women in hospital who are recovering from breast surgery
- * Carol Lindsay hosts a knitting group who make beautiful comforting rugs for gifts and for people in crisis in both Africa and locally.
- * Birthing Kits -Wendy Downes and Pammie Harrison working in conjunction with secondary school students to collect and package safe and hygienic birthing equipment for women in third world countries.
- * Bookclub Kerry Kenyon providing opportunities for a shared meal and book discussion.

These ongoing projects are opportunities for fellowship and friendship in a relaxed atmosphere and allow members to get to know each other better.

ADVOCACY

To cover all the responsibilities of an Advocacy Committee (see Club Manual p30), members already committed to this team (Roz, Meagan, Patsy, Mandy, Maxine, Mary & Sandii) have accepted responsibility for specific areas and they will be seeking your assistance throughout the year. The most urgent call for action at our June meeting will be to plan and implement our presence at the Reef Festival Parade, to be held on Saturday 4 August; Patsy will be seeking ideas as well as participants for this committee.

We would like at least one major advocacy project to advertise the aims of Zonta and publicise our Club. Previous initiatives have included our ongoing Orange Ladies and the Orange Shoe display at the markets. ZONTA INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

An important decision at the Zonta International Convention will be the selection of major projects to which funding will be directed during the 2019-20 Biennium. A full list of current projects can be accessed at https://foundation.zonta.org/ (or from the ZI home page click on Foundation at top left) and go to 'our programmes'.

In advocating fundraising for Zonta, we should highlight the distinction, both at local and International level, between Membership fees, which cover administration costs, and Fundraising contributions, which are 100% directed to the projects we support.

Also note that every ZI project is in partnership with a United Nations organisation and as such is well researched, long term and effective. All are closely monitored with detailed reports regularly released. Of all the impressive achievements documented, a recent report on the 'Let us Learn Madagascar' project was particularly close to my personal focus on the education of young women. One of many milestones reached in 2017 was:

Catch-up Classes • 100 school teachers and principals from 36 lower secondary schools were trained to provide catch-up classes to students before the start of the new academic year in October. • An estimated 700 girls who had dropped out of school participated in catch-up classes, exceeding the original target by 42 percent.


